

Hello! I know many of you have questions as we end the school year. I am going to try to answer all of the most common "end-of-school" inquiries that we get. If I have missed your questions, please let me know.

***When is the last day of school?**

The last day of school is scheduled for May 22 (K-8) and May 21 (Preschool). Friday, May 22, students will be dismissed at 1 p.m.

***What kind of lunch charges do I owe?**

We are sending an updated lunch balance sheet home with every K-8 student on Friday. Please look in their bags for it. Lunches need to be paid in full by the last day of school to get their report card.

***How many PSH do I still need?**

On the lunch balance sheet you will have your PSH balance as well. If you are far from your 15 hours you have 2 options: If you haven't done any hours you can just pay the \$50. If you have done some hours and need more, please contact the school. We have so many opportunities in the last few days of school. As my husband's granny always says, "Many hands make light work."

***When will we get our standardized test results?**

You will receive standardized test results in July by mail when you also receive your supply list. If you would like them before, you can contact me in June. We try to save postage by mailing it all at once.

***When is the 2009-2010 school year deposit due?**

The deposit for next year is due on June 12th. We use this deposit money to buy supplies for the next school year. This money is taken off of your tuition balance.

***What if I want my tuition payments to continue through the summer?**

***What will you do on the last day of school? Are my kids required to come?**

The last day of school is called a "Fun Day". We will be playing some group games (great opportunity for PSH time) and spending time together for the last time as a class. You are welcome to come for lunch but we must know by Wednesday the 20th that you are coming. The menu is hot dogs/chips. Students are not required to come but are strongly encouraged to come to close out the school year.

We will have an 8th grade graduation on Wednesday, May 20th during chapel. Any of you are welcome to attend.
